



Techny Arborviate - Winter hardy and drought resistant. Grows well in full sun or light shade. Not recommended for roadsides, salt spray sensitive.

**Leaf:** Tiny green leaves that cling to the stems like scales. The smaller branches are arranged in sprays, and the growth is upright and dense

**Flower:** Brown, Spring

**Fruit:** The tree produces male and female cones that are only 1/2 inch long. The cones form at the tips of branches and grow in an upward direction. They start out green and turn brown as they mature. Unlike the open cones of pines, arborvitae cones look like tiny scale-covered eggs.

**Twig:**

**Bark:** The bark of the arborvitae is gray, turning a reddish color as it ages. Furrows in the gray bark show the reddish color that will eventually be more prevalent

**Form:** Pyramidal
