

Minutes of the first meeting of the  
Belle Creek Watershed district held at 1:30 pm  
Thursday December 26, 1968 in the Belle Creek  
township hall Goodhue Minnesota

All the managers of the Belle Creek Watershed  
district were present at the above location for an  
orientation by Mr Weiberg on some of the  
managers' duties and necessary actions to be taken,  
all pursuant to Chapter 112, Minnesota Statutes.  
Mr Arnold Wiebusch, Soil Conservation Agent,  
Goodhue County Conservation Agent,  
Goodhue County Extension Service,  
also was present.

Matters reviewed and discussed by Mr Weiberg  
with the managers were a need to prepare and adopt  
an overall Plan "112.46" appointment of an  
Advisory Committee "112.44" the hiring of certain  
employees "112.45" procedure for securing  
organizational and administrative funds "112.41"  
the relationship of the proposed Belle Creek  
Project Plan prepared by the Soil Conservation  
service, to the watershed district, and the  
need for cooperation with other local units  
of government

Certain documents, maps, and papers  
relative to ~~the~~ district matters were  
given to the managers by Mr Weiberg

Meeting called to order by Mr. Arnold Wiebusch  
Soil Conservation Agent Goodhue County  
Temporary Chairman of the meeting  
Mr. Wiebusch appointed Mr. Weiberg  
Secretary Pro-Tem Managers present were

Mr. Robert Farrell Goodhue Min  
Mr. Albert Kunde Goodhue Min

Mr Alva C. Rapp Cannon Falls Min  
Mr. Farrell and Mr. Rapp delivered to  
Mr. Weiberg for filing with the secretary of the  
Water resources board an Oath as defined  
in Minnesota Constitution Article 5 sec 8  
and a bond in the sum of \$1,000 Mr Kunde  
reported that he had made application to his  
bank for his bond and oath and would forward  
the necessary papers to the secretary of the  
water resources board

The law relative to the organization of the board was read followed by ~~a~~ a discussion on procedure for election of officers; it was moved by Mr Kunde to vote by ballot, seconded by Mr Farrell, passed unanimously. Mr Wiesbusch appointed Mr Weilberg as teller.

Mr Kunde nominated Mr Farrell for President. Mr Farrell nominated Mr Kunde for President. Mr Kunde moved nominations cease seconded by Mr Farrell. Motion passed. Mr Weilberg counted the ballots and announced that Mr. Farrell had been elected President.

Mr Rapp nominated Mr Kunde for secretary. Mr Farrel nominated Mr Rapp for secretary. Mr Kunde moved nominations cease seconded by Mr Rapp.

Motion carried. Mr Weilberg counted the ballots and announced that Mr Rapp was elected secretary.

Mr Farrell moved that a white ballot be cast for Mr Kunde as treasurer seconded by Mr Rapp. Motion carried. Mr Kunde was duly elected as treasurer.

Motion by Mr Farrell seconded by Mr Kunde authorizing the secretary to secure for the district the necessary books, stamp & stationary, including a minute book within the amount of \$50.00 dollars. Motion passed.

The Managers agreed to meet next on Jan 6 1969 at 1-30 PM at the home of the President.

Motion by Mr Rapp to adjourn seconded by Mr Kunde, motion passed.

Minutes of the second meeting of the  
Belle Creek Watershed district held at the home of the  
President Robert Farrell on Tuesday Jan 14 1969

The meeting was called to order by the president  
Mr. Farrell. The minutes of the organizational  
meeting was not read as each member had a  
copy sent to them by the secretary Rapp.  
The major portion of the afternoon was spent  
studying the material given to the managers by Mr.  
Weiberg.

The compensation of the managers was  
discussed. The managers were in agreement that the  
district would not have an overabundance of money  
to spend. A motion by Mr. Rapp to pay  
\$15.00 for an afternoon or evening meeting and \$35.00  
for an all day meeting plus mileage at 940 per  
mile and expenses incurred in the performance  
of their duties. A motion by Mr. Farrell  
to pay advisory committee on the same basis  
seconded by Mr. Rapp. Motion carried.

The naming of an advisory committee  
was then taken up. It was agreed that we  
would each contact someone who would agree to  
serve on the advisory committee and bring  
them to another later meeting, and ask  
Mr. Weiberg to attend and give them instructions.

The question of legal counsel came before the  
meeting as Mr. Farrell had received a letter from  
Mr. Frank Murray attorney at law from St Paul  
who had offered his service. It was decided  
to ask him to come to a latter meeting with Mr.  
Weiberg for an interview.

The secretary was instructed to  
print 500 letterheads & envelopes for the District.

Mr. Farrell offered to see the County  
Auditor and alert him that we would be needing  
funds for operating expenses.

Mr. Kunkle was to see Commissioner  
Henry Peterson to represent the County  
board on the advisory committee.

As it was getting late Mr. Rapp made a  
motion to adjourn seconded by Mr. Kunkle.  
Motion carried.

The meeting was called to order by the Pres Robert Farrell the advisory committee which had been split into teams to work on various sections in preparing the overall Plan reported their finding all were present except Mr Fredrickson & Mr Ryan. Arnold Weibusch of the Goodhue County extension service sat in at the meeting.

Harold Buck of team no 1 reported on the introduction. How the district was started, the meetings held, the officers elected, the makeup of the steering committee and proceedings leading to the hearing before the water resource board held at the Winsted school on July 12 - 1968 and the appointment of the dist- first Manager.

Mr Robert Farrell of team No 2 reported on the description of the dist-, its location, size topography Geology, slope, watercourse its people and type of farming Etc

Albert Kunde of team No 3 reported on the Problems of the dist- Auto storms, flooding, erosion; siltation destruction of property Public roads bridges and culverts, fences, crops buildings, solutions; interference of school bus transportation and delivery of produce to market

Elmer Morris Goodhue Co Engineer being present reported on costs incurred by the County, on roads, bridges and culverts. And the possible savings in rebuilding costs.

David Langsdorf of team No 4 gave the report on the solutions and objectives, And how to treat the above problems and on the proposed structures types

And their location

Mr Rapp of team No 5 gave the report on the Policies of the dist- how it should be run and administered after the advisory committee left the Managers proceeded with the following business, The minutes of the previous meetings were read and approved

The following resolution was introduced by Mr Albert Kunde and passed

Whereas the Belle Creek watershed dist is in need of funds for organization the preparation of an overall Plan to pay per diem + mileage and other expenses incurred in carrying out the business of the district therefore be it resolved that the secretary of the distat prepare a directive authorizing the County Auditor to make advancement of funds as prescribed by law
